



Cookie Policy

This Policy explains what cookies are and how we use them. It includes details of the types of Cookies we set, the information we collect when using them and how that information is used.

What Are Cookies?

Cookies are small text files which are stored on your browser when you visit a website. They can often serve crucial functions and help us to keep our website secure and to function properly which helps us to provide you with a better experience. They can also help us to analyse how the website performs, what works and where we can make improvements.

How We Use Cookies?

We use Strictly Necessary, Analytics and Targeting / Marketing cookies. These are used to understand how our website performs, how you interact with it, and helps us to provide you with a better, faster and improved experience. We don't use advertising cookies.

Social Media and External Links – where you access us via external links or social media platforms, we also have no control over those websites and the cookies they set, so please bear in mind that you should set your preferences in line with their own policies and cookie controls separately.

Please Remember: We want you to be safe when you are sharing your personal data and to understand what this means for you. Please remember, when clicking on external links via our website or when you find us via social media platforms, you are visiting or redirected to the domain of those websites.

We have no control over the privacy settings on these firms or their websites or the cookies they set, so please bear in mind that you should always review their privacy information and where required you should set your preferences in line with their own policies and cookie controls separately.

How to Manage Cookies – When you visit our site you will be asked if you want to accept cookies. You can continue to use the site without accepting these and any non-necessary cookies will not load onto your browser.

What Cookies Do We Set?

Necessary Cookies

We use necessary functional cookies which are needed for security and for the website to function. They do not collect your personal data. These are automatically enabled when you visit the site, however you can still remove these cookies via your browser, however disabling these will affect the functionality of the site.

Analytics Cookies

We use Analytics cookies to help us to understand how the number of visitors to our website and how they interact with it, for example which pages are visited and for how long. These help us to continually improve our website and services. The data is reported anonymously without any personal data included.

Targeting / Marketing Cookies

Targeting / Marketing cookies are used to provide visitors with relevant ads and marketing campaigns. These cookies track visitors across websites and collect information to provide customised advertising and marketing.
